

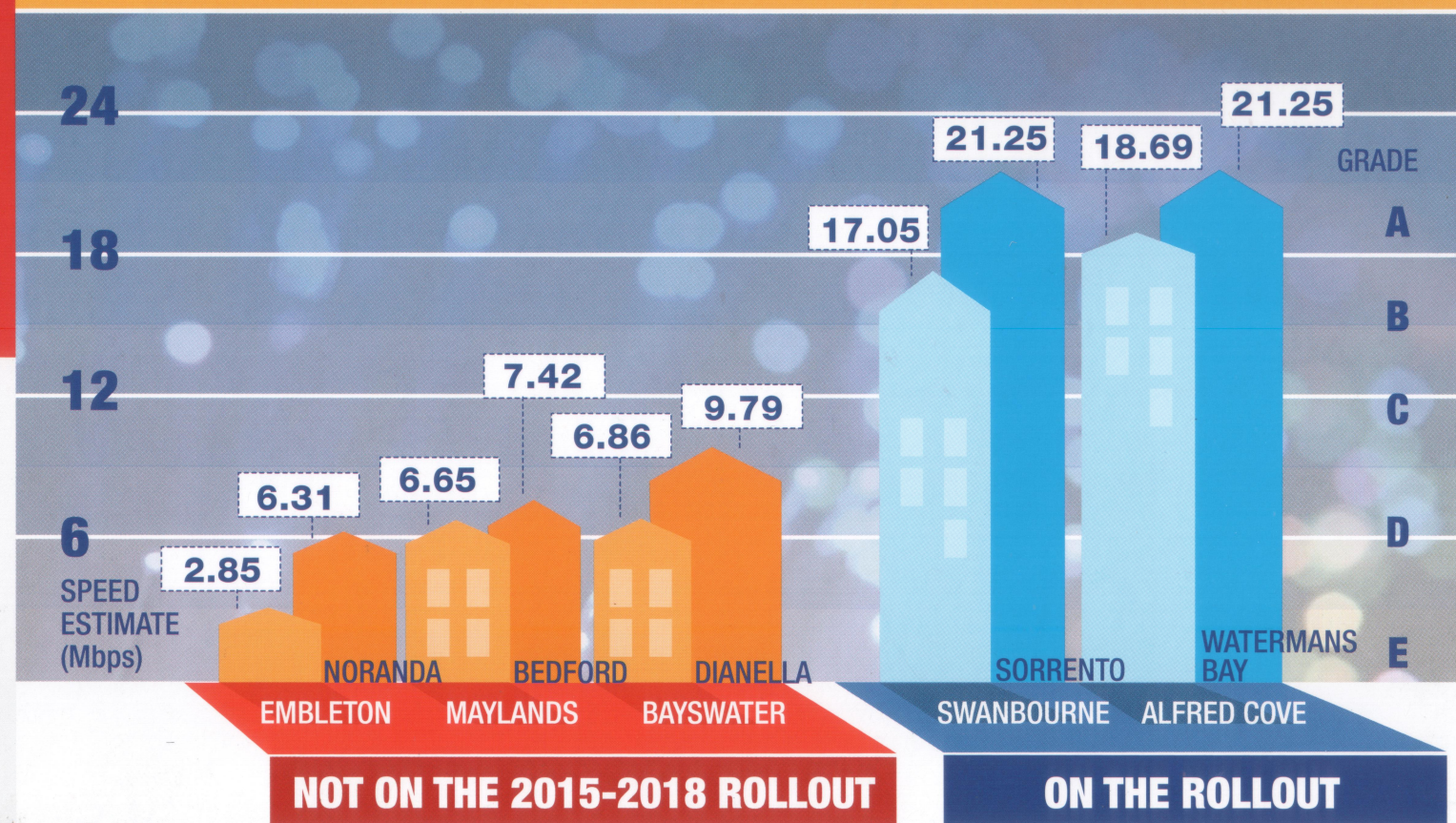
NBN — NOT IN YOUR FRONT YARD

WHAT TURNBULL PROMISED...

- All homes and businesses would have NBN access by 2016
- Those with the worst broadband would get it first
- The second-rate NBN, using old copper wire, would be cheaper, at \$29.5 billion

WHAT IS BEING DELIVERED...



- ✗ Homes and businesses in Bedford, Maylands, Embleton, Inglewood, Noranda and Dianella are left off the rollout – no NBN before 2019 at the earliest
- ✗ These suburbs have some of the nation's worst speeds, but still aren't on the rollout
- ✗ The second-rate NBN has doubled in cost – to \$56 billion
